The usefulness of the cerebellar markers and stereotaxic frame during the removal of meningiomas was studied in 9 patients. The main objective was to assess whether these markers help to reduce the number of intraoperative malpositionings and whether they offer improved overall tumor removal. The number of malpositionings was reduced with the cerebellar markers, but not with the stereotaxic frame. The lesion removal was better with the cerebellar markers than without. As a consequence, the mean postoperative Karnofsky Performance Scale was 90% with the use of the cerebellar markers and 56% without. The mean postoperative Hamilton Depression Rating Scale was 37% with the use of the markers and 17% without. A satisfactory postoperative outcome can be expected if the markers are used during the surgery.George E. V. Hayden George Edwin Vere P.
